### **A Note From Pastor Jody**

I asked our Children's Director, Pam Swedburg, to give me a report on how VBS went this past week. I asked her how it went, and how she saw God move in special and inspiring ways. Here is what she said...

“We praise God for the opportunity to teach kids about Jesus and this week of VBS changed eternity! Ten kids asked Jesus to be their forever friend and we rejoice that they made the decision to follow Jesus. Seeds were planted in the lives of 259 children who attended this week.

Our five lessons revolved around the life of Peter. He was an ordinary man who allowed God to use him. Children learned that they were accepted by Jesus, protected by Jesus, saved by Jesus, forgiven by Jesus and can live for Jesus.

This year's mission project was to purchase an ATV for the Oberg's to use in their ministry in Africa. Our goal was to raise half the purchase price for the ATV (\$2500). Every year we are humbled by the generous and sacrificial giving of the children. By Thursday, the offering was \$1445.12. Friday morning we celebrated when Mark and Debbie showed a check for \$4071.74!! God is so faithful! The children (and adults) thanked God as we cheered and shouted praise to Him.

I am deeply thankful for the 145 volunteers who gave their time and energy to make this week of ministry possible. Some of them took vacation or time off from work to minister to the children. It's wonderful to see God working in the lives of our volunteers as well as the children.
