A Note From Pastor Jody

Can a person ever get so bad...so sinful...so wicked...that God is no longer capable of saving him or her? After being personally responsible for the death of more than 6 million Jews, was Hitler simply beyond the reach of God's grace? Is

it possible for someone to simply be so cruel, and guilty of so many crimes, that before the moment of their death there is just no hope for them?

And what about the unpardonable sin that Jesus spoke of...that of blaspheming the Holy Spirit. Does that sin condemn a person to hell years before their eventual death? When Jesus was looking at and talking to the Pharisees when he spoke of this, was He basically telling them that they were permanently and hopelessly out of bounds and that God could no longer save them?

This morning we're looking at the life of one of the worst men who ever lived. His name was King Manasseh. I mentioned Hitler a moment ago. Manasseh was right there in that same league. He was a king of the Jews who was responsible for killing untold numbers of the Godliest Jews of his day. He turned to every god possible OTHER THAN Jehovah God. He worshipped Satan. You name it, and Manasseh topped the list.

If there was ever a man who, by the choices he made and the life he lived, was beyond the reach of God's grace...it was Manasseh. He was the very last man on the face of the earth who you would think would be saved.

And yet...

Amazing grace how sweet the sound, that saved a wretch like me. Grace, grace, God's grace...grace that is greater than all my sin. You see, God's arm of grace is the longest arm in the world. If outer space goes on for infinity...and it may very well do that...then know that God's arm of mercy and salvation is infinitely longer than that. Our God is mighty to save.
