Simply due to the unavailability of parts and repairs, Kevin was thinking maybe the wisest thing to do was to buy a slightly used unit and then buy a second unit as a back up/ parts option. He was also hoping for something more basic.

He finally found a guy who was selling a 2008 almost new model for \$4,700. So, he thought he would go

with that and try to find a second one for the remaining money. He tried to call the guy to confirm that we would buy it last night, but couldn't get a hold of him. This morning the guy said that we could come and get it this evening.

At lunch, Kevin prayed that if this wasn't the right move, that God would make it clear. This afternoon, the guy called and said that he had sold it to someone else! Kevin was a bit discouraged, but we remembered our prayer and that this must be God's answer.

So, Kevin started making phone calls again and you'll never believe it! He called a dealer in Woodburn who happened to have TWO brand new 2008 ATVs that were very basic – ex-

actly what we had been looking for all along but had never been able to find. And the cost? It was \$7,200 – almost exactly what the Moses Lake Alliance Church VBS had raised, and we've got a bit left over for registration fees. WOW!! We're really amazed – exactly what we need, the right price, a back-up ATV, basic, and heavy-duty to pull the trailers.

Anyway, just wanted to share this miracle story with you – with how everything has worked together in the funds and purchase. We can't wait to see what God has planned in the usage!
